Entries must be printed double-spaced and in a regular 12-pitch font (italics or bold are of course acceptable as part of an occasional desired effect). A normal maximum of 20 pages should be observed by each entrant. Writers of lengthy prose fiction and writers of drama may submit a single work of fiction or drama up to 40 double-spaced pages but should not include any other works in their submission.

The competition is restricted to students who have not previously won the First Prize.

NB: Submissions (in TRIPLICATE) should be handed in to the Student Affairs Office (Arts 155). (Three copies of one submission in one sealed envelope (8 ½ x 11) with this form stapled to the front.)
