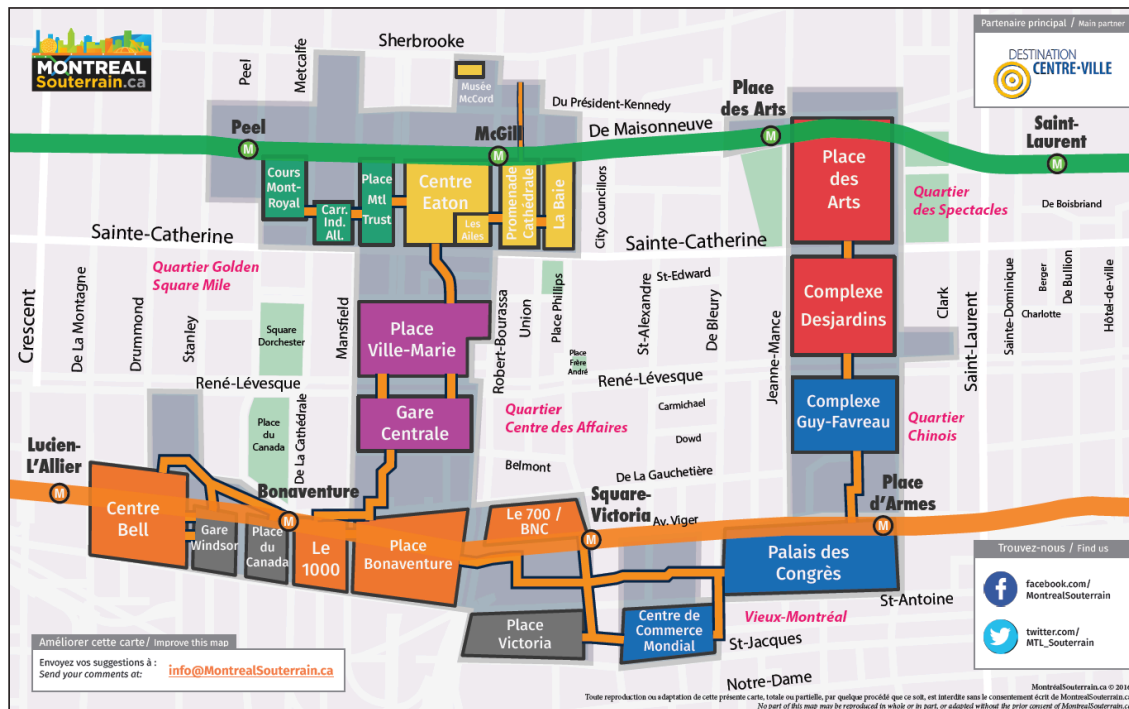

- Check in at McGill Bronfman Building



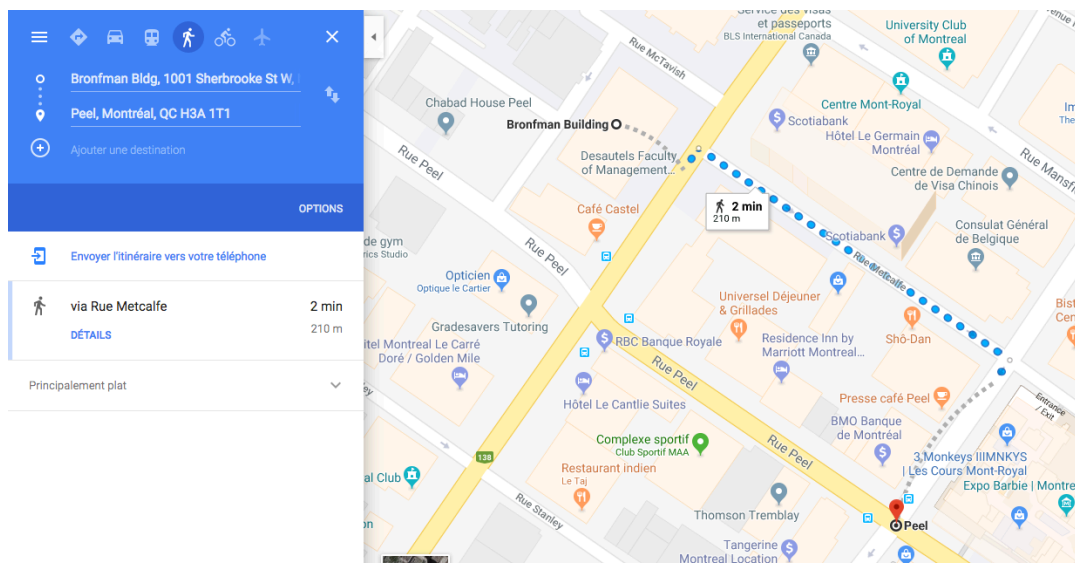
