

Graduate Research Enhancement and Travel Awards (*GREAT* Awards)

Cell Biology Graduate Program

GREAT award funds are allocated to Faculties to be disbursed to graduate students. These awards cover dissemination of research through graduate student presentations at conferences, and other graduate student research-enhancement activities, such as travel for fieldwork, archival inquiry and extra-mural collaborative research.

For the academic year 2017-2018, the Cell and Molecular Biology Graduate Program has been allocated \$2,500

Eligibility:

- Any Master's student (MSc 1-3) or Doctoral student (PhD 1-7) in good standing, registered full time, and not in time limitation. For further information, please visit:
- Applicants must not have access to a major source of travel funds, such as these provided by CIHR Doctoral Research Awards for example.
- Applicants must declare any other source of travel funds in the application. If the candidate is successful in obtaining additional funding (such as award from the conference for example), he/she must return any double reimbursement to the Anatomy GREAT reward funds.
- Criteria used in the selection process for the Graduate Research Enhancement and Travel (GREAT) Award may vary depending on the number of applicants, the funds requested, and the available funds. Preference may be given to students applying for an oral presentation, students applying to attend an international conference, students who have not previously received a GREAT award, and students who may otherwise not be able to attend the conference. The award amount will be announced after all applications are submitted.

Complete applications should be submitted by the below listed deadlines:

Oct 1, 2017: For any conference/research related travel between Oct 1, 2017–March 31, 2018

March 1, 2018: For any conference/research related travel between April 1, 2018–Sept 31, 2018
