

# Doreen Laszlo Fellowship Announcement

McGill's Faculty of Dentistry is pleased to offer one "Doreen Laszlo fellowship" of \$12,000/yr over 3 years for a PhD student and 2 years for an MSc student. The award is for a DMD/DDS student or graduate of a DMD/DDS program who will undertake or is undertaking graduate studies in the Faculty of Dentistry at McGill University. This amount will be added to the usual stipend over 2-3 years that the supervisor commits to the awardee. The award will be provided as of January 2018 and cover the 2017-18 academic year.

## Eligibility criteria

The candidate must:

- Be a Canadian citizen or landed immigrant;
- Hold a DMD/DDS degree or equivalent;
- Have a GPA over 3.5 (or equivalent); and
- Be working or will be working with a research supervisor appointed in the Faculty of Dentistry at McGill University (Associate Member and Adjunct Professor appointments are not included).

The supervisor must:

- Continue to provide the stipend that they had already committed to for the candidate; and
- Commit to minimally match the same amount as the award, so the student receives \$24,000/year minimally for 2 and 3 years for MSc or PhD students respectively.

## Application process

Applicants must submit the following documentation to Maria Palumbo (maria.palumbo2@mcgill.ca):

- Official transcript
- Final DMD/DDS diploma (if incomplete at time of application, it should be provided before starting the graduate program)
- A maximum 1-page letter stating why the candidate wants to do graduate studies
- An updated CV
- A letter from the potential supervisor indicating his/her financial commitment
- Two letters of recommendation from previous supervisors or instructors
- A one-page description of the project
