Applicants at the Assistant Professor rank should have several years of experience with demonstrated proficiency in research through publications in top-tier academic journals, and with demonstrated ability in teaching and willingness to contribute to service activities. Applicants at the Associate and Full Professor ranks should have a strong publication record in top-tier academic journals, and provide evidence of strong teaching and services. Rank and salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Applicants should include a cover letter, curriculum vitae, a statement of current and prospective research interests, three letters of references and a sample research paper in their applications. Applications should be submitted at:
