

The following curriculum changes will be effective as of Fall 2008 and apply to students currently registered in the **Electrical Engineering Program**:

ECSE 200 and 210 (changes apply to all programs)

Starting in September 2008, these courses will have 4 scheduled lecture hours per week. The fourth lecture hour is yet to be scheduled. This additional hour will not be used for new lecture material, but for a weekly quizz. It is essential that students registering for these courses have no schedule conflicts with any of the 4 lecture hours. These two courses are temporarily closed and it will be open for registration as soon as the revised schedule is confirmed.

ECSE 420, Parallel Computing

ECSE 420, Parallel Computing, has now been added to the list of technical complementaries. This change will be reflected on the 2008/09 curriculum.

ECSE 423 – Fundamentals of Photonics (Prerequisite Change)

PHYS 271, Quantum Physics, has been dropped from the list of prerequisites. The only prerequisite for this course is ECSE 352, Electromagnetic Waves.
