

The following curriculum changes apply to students currently registered in the **Software Engineering Program**.

COMP 361 Systems Programming Project

Effective September 2010, the course COMP 361 will no longer be part of the Software Engineering program. It is replaced by ECSE 211 (Design Methodology and Principles). The total credit weight for the program remains unchanged.

For students who have completed COMP 361, no further action is required.

Students who have not yet completed COMP 361 must take ECSE 211 instead, since COMP 361 is no longer available as a 3 credit course.

ECSE 211 is given in both Fall and Winter terms, but has limited enrollment. Priority will be given to graduating students and you will require a “permit override” to register. Please contact the Undergraduate program Office at undergrad.ece@mcgill.ca for the permit to register and make sure you include your McGill ID, CRN of the course and your **graduation date** in your email. Please check Minerva for the schedule.

COMP 573 Microcomputers

COMP 573 has not been taught for a number of years and therefore it has been removed from the list of technical complementaries.
