Students seeking exemption from one or more English program requirements must see the appropriate advisor. **If an exemption is granted, it must be recorded in the way described for relevant courses taken elsewhere, as above. The signed program audit sheet must be returned to the Department of English General Office, Arts 155, for inclusion in the student's file.**
