


The pre-200209 legacy term (pre-Banner) includes: part-time, Continuing Education, session of admission, thesis continuing, session of graduation, half-time, and leave of absence.

As of fall 2004, the non resident exchange students are reported under full-time "load".

These statistics are headcounts of students, based on their primary curriculum.

"Faculties of Arts and Science" includes students that are registered in both Arts and Science and are pursuing the B.A.&Sc. degree.
