Full-time "loads" for the 2015 and 2014 terms includes: full-time, non-resident, thesis full-time, thesis additional session, visiting additional session, thesis evaluation, thesis continuing and non resident exchange.

The pre-200209 legacy term (pre-Banner) includes: full-time, additional session and non-resident.

Part-time "loads" for the 2015 and 2014 terms includes: part-time, Continuing Education, leave of absence, no credits, thesis half-time and unknown time status. The pre-200209 legacy term (pre-Banner) includes: part-time, Continuing Education, session of admission, thesis continuing, session of graduation, half-time, and leave of absence.

As of fall 2004, the non resident exchange students are reported under full-time "load".
