

TIMELINE FOR THE Ph.D. FROM ADMISSION TO FINAL SUBMISSION

ADMISSIONS COMMITTEE

- Recommends admission

ACCEPTANCE INTO PH.D. PROGRAM

- (course credit requirements: 12/18 credits)
- Registration in July/August for September admissions.
 - Registration in November/December for January admissions

What are your next steps?

INITIAL MEETING WITH SUPERVISOR (Within 2 months of first registration)

- Research objectives and timelines are established;
- Thesis committee members are determined;
 - Letter of Understanding is completed.

1ST THESIS COMMITTEE MEETING (Year 1) September admissions: between the months of March and June; January: between September and

December

- Student presents thesis project and results obtained;
- Graduate Student's Research Progress Tracking
 Form and Minutes are completed by the
 Academic Advisor.

RESEARCH WORK CONTINUES

COMPREHENSIVE ORAL EXAMINATION (Year 2)

- Student presents thesis project and results obtained;
 - Comprehensive knowledge is tested;
- Graduate Student's Research Progress
 Tracking Form and Minutes are completed by the Academic Advisor.

THESIS COMMITTEE MEETINGS (Year 3 to ...)

- Student presents thesis project and results obtained;
- Graduate Student's Research Progress Tracking Form and Minutes are completed by the Academic Advisor.

FINAL THESIS COMMITTEE MEETING, at which time an outline of the proposed thesis is presented and discussed with the committee members and permission to write is obtained.

RESEARCH WORK
CONTINUES
Course work completed by
Ph.D. 4 year

DEFENSE (Scheduled with the Division)
REPORTS from reviewers are received
within 4 weeks of initial thesis
submission.
