With CIET (a research NGO), she has led community-based research on structural determinants of health in some 20 countries, especially in South Asia and Southern Africa, with a focus on access to services by the most vulnerable, and working with providers and policy makers to use evidence to improve services. She currently leads a national stepped-wedge trial of structural interventions for HIV prevention in Botswana (INSTRUCT).
