

You will likely receive 6-12 credits toward your BCOM degree with a grade of 5 or higher.

For each IB paper you completed without doing the certificate we will not see your results automatically. You must let us know!!

If you completed one or two university or college courses prior to McGill, you would need to submit an official transcript and may receive credit and-or exemption if the course is deemed equivalent from a recognized university or college after evaluation.

Contact your **examining board** to send your official results and to avoid registration and graduation delays and fines.


#### **IB STUDENTS**
