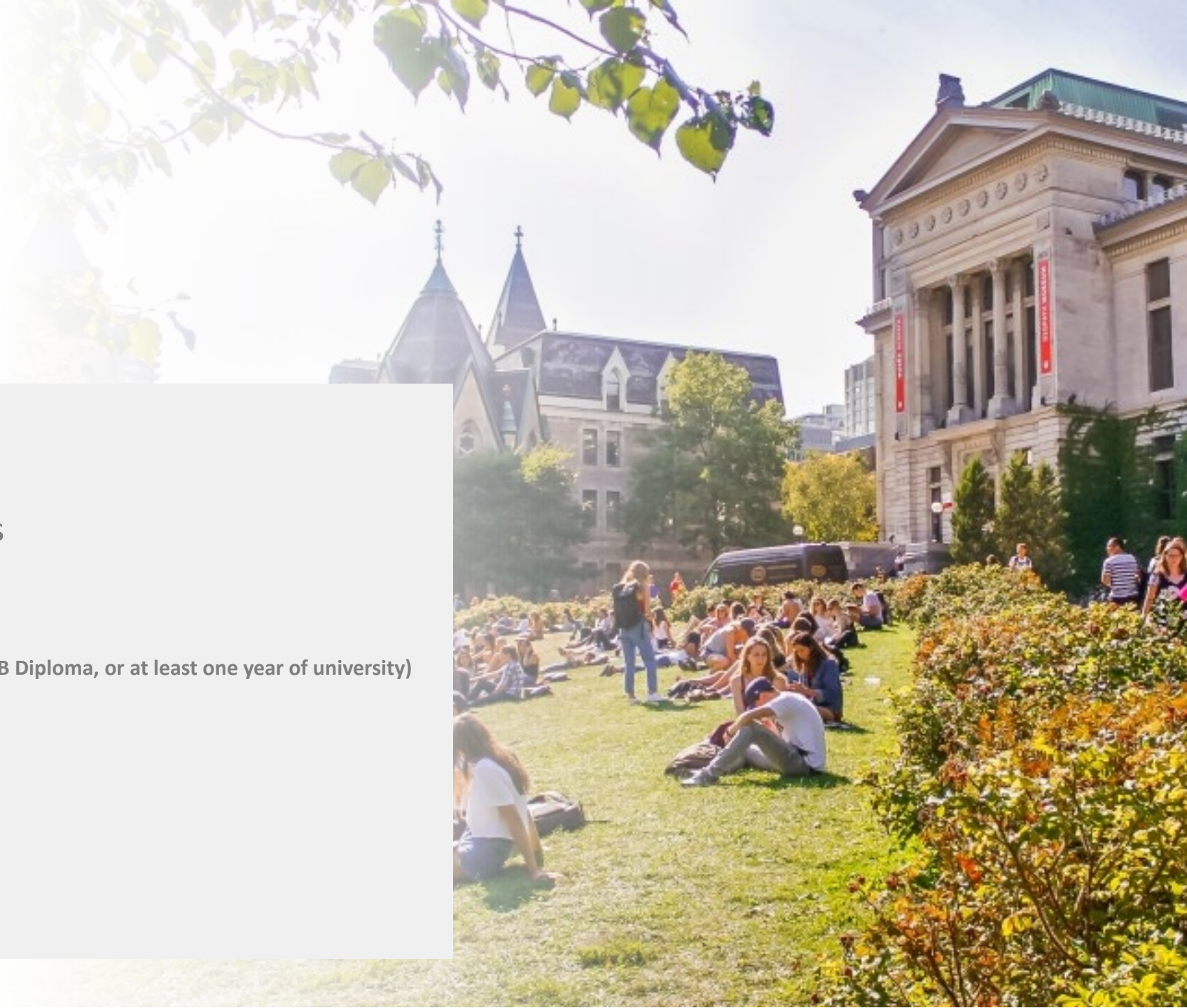

International Management Major

Language Component

12 credits

(must reach intermediate level of a language)

Should consider starting in first term (U0 or U1)

Access to CORE courses in U0

The courses below will be available to U0 students:

- **MGCR 250 Expressive Analysis for Mgmt. (must be taken in U0)**
- **MGCR 233 Intro to Data Programming (must be taken in U0)**
- ***MGCR 222 Organizational Behavior (optional U0 course)**
- ***MGCR 352 Marketing (optional U0 course)**
- ***MGCR 211 Financial Accounting (optional U0 course)**

Optional CORE courses, if not taken in U0 can be taken in U1 or after.

To help adjust to university studies, please make sure to balance the CORE courses between both terms or you can focus on electives or consider beginning them in the winter term.

PRE MCGILL CREDITS – What to expect

AP Credits

For each AP exam with a grade of 4 or higher, 3 credits will be granted toward your McGill degree

Generic exemption ie.
ENGL 1xx
ECON 1xx

Direct McGill exemption ie. Math 140, COMP 202
(no credit granted for MATH 203)

Course overlap: You cannot receive credit for the same course or its equivalent twice. If you repeat a course, it will be excluded from both credits and GPA.

If you are changing from U0 to U1, you will have to register now as a U0 and contact us when the AP credits are on your unofficial transcript. We cannot change your registration until you are officially U1.

IB Papers

only without certificate and University Credit

You will likely receive 6-12 credits toward your BCOM degree with a grade of 5 or higher.

Generic exemption ie.
ENGL 1xx
ECON 1xx

For each IB paper you completed without doing the certificate we will not see your results automatically. You must let us know!!

If you completed one or two university or college courses prior to McGill, you would need to submit an official transcript and may receive credit and-or exemption if the course is deemed equivalent from a recognized university or college after evaluation.

Consult an advisor for the steps to process credit requests.

Official Documents

Official documents must be received by [SERVICE POINT](#) as soon as possible.

A-LEVELS & APs

Contact your **examining board** to send your official results and to avoid registration and graduation delays and fines.

IB STUDENTS

No action required.

FB STUDENTS

You may receive only one copy of your results, in this case, take them to Service Point in person to get credit.

Periodically check your transcript to ensure you do not have any holds.
