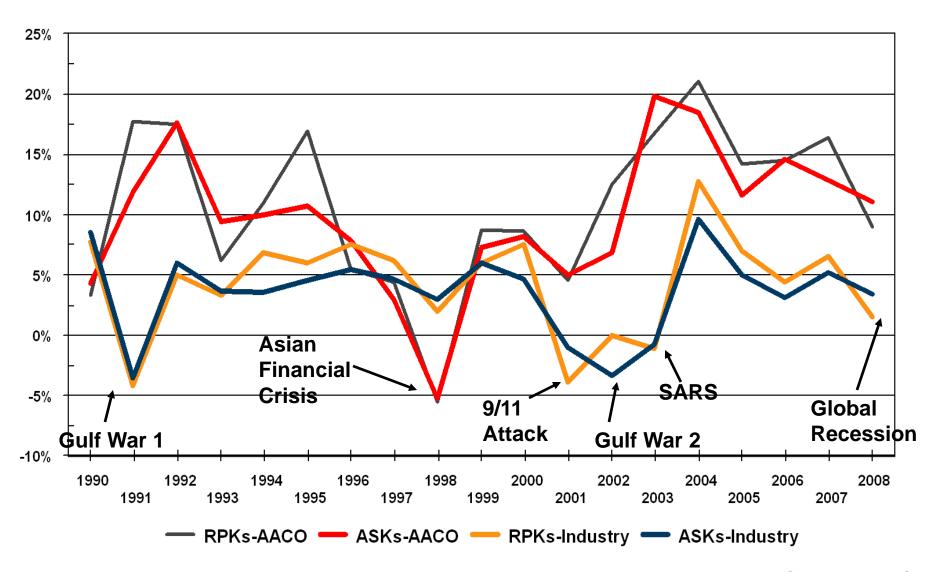

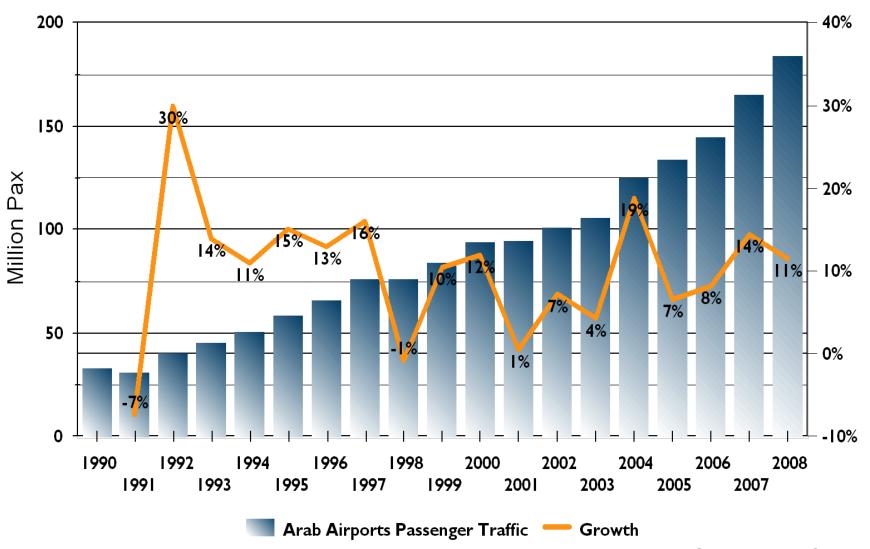
AACO Members and Industry RPKs and ASKs growth

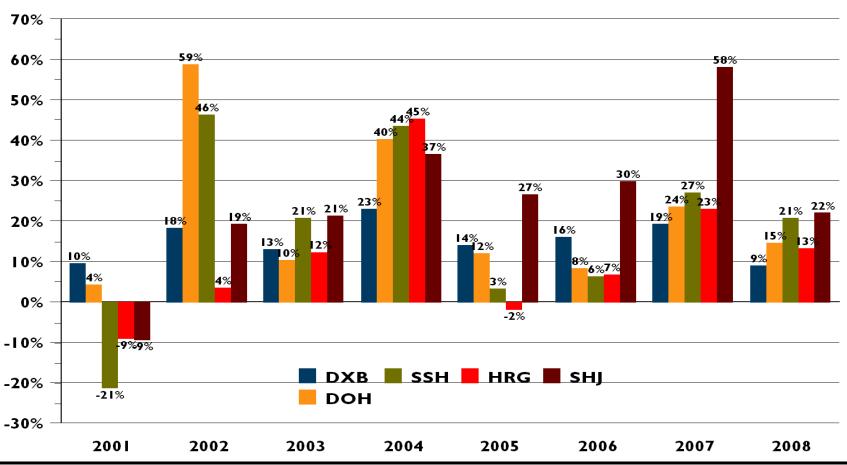

Top Five Growing Arab Airports

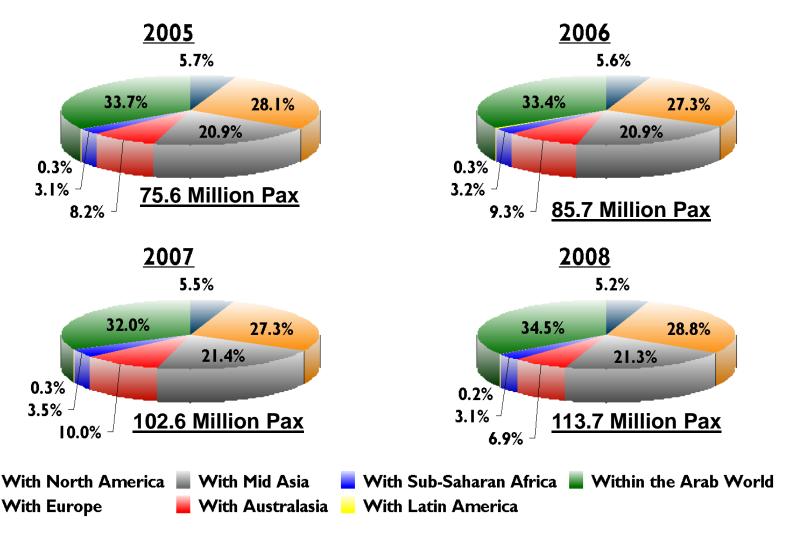

Arab Air Transport Market

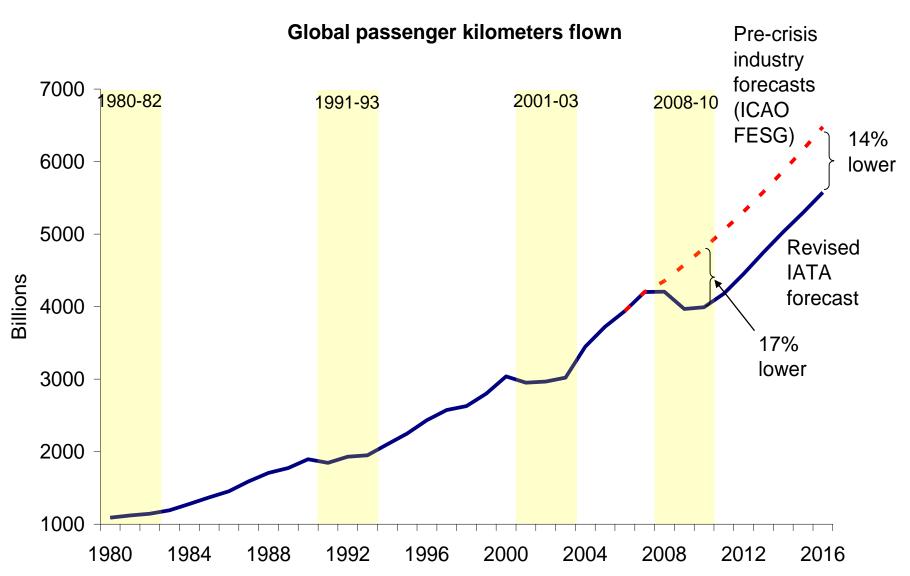
Size and Distribution of Traffic

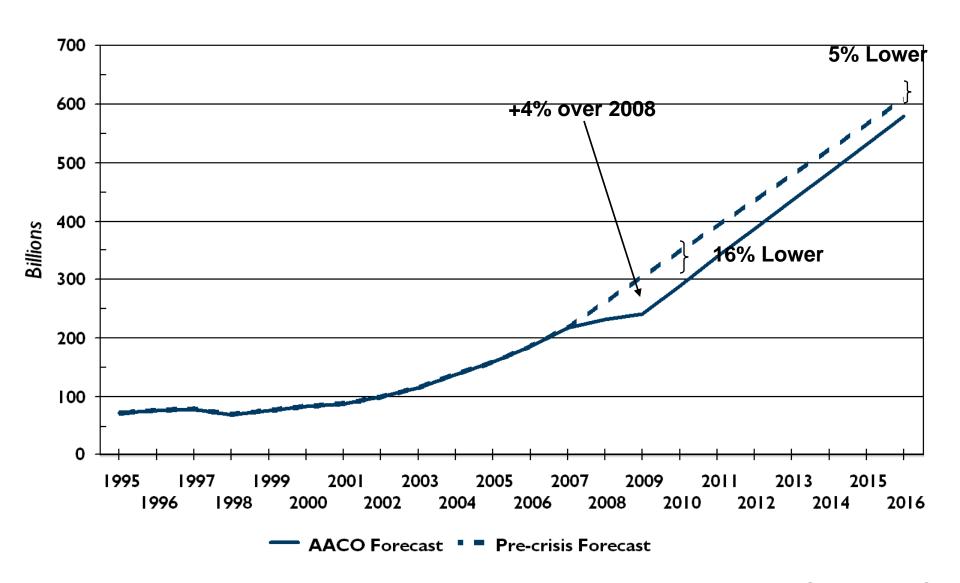
Effects of the crisis on Arab Aviation

IATA Industry Forecast



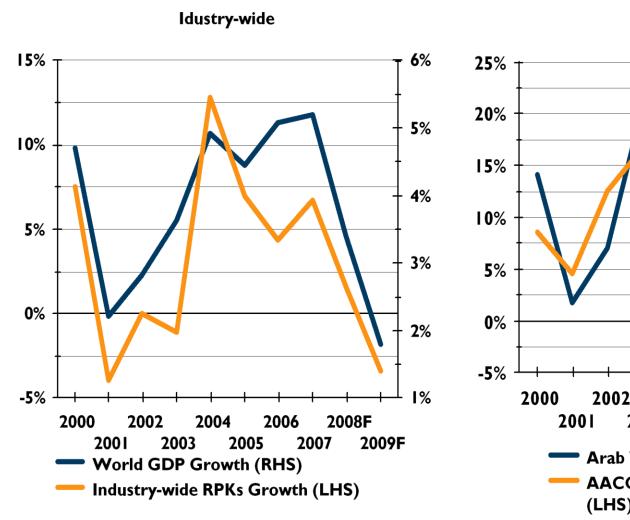

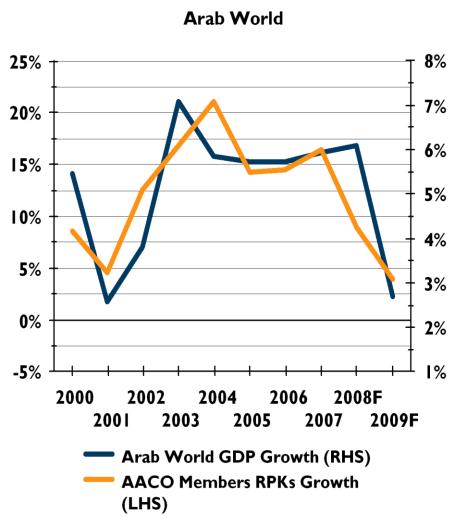
AACO Members RPKs Forecast

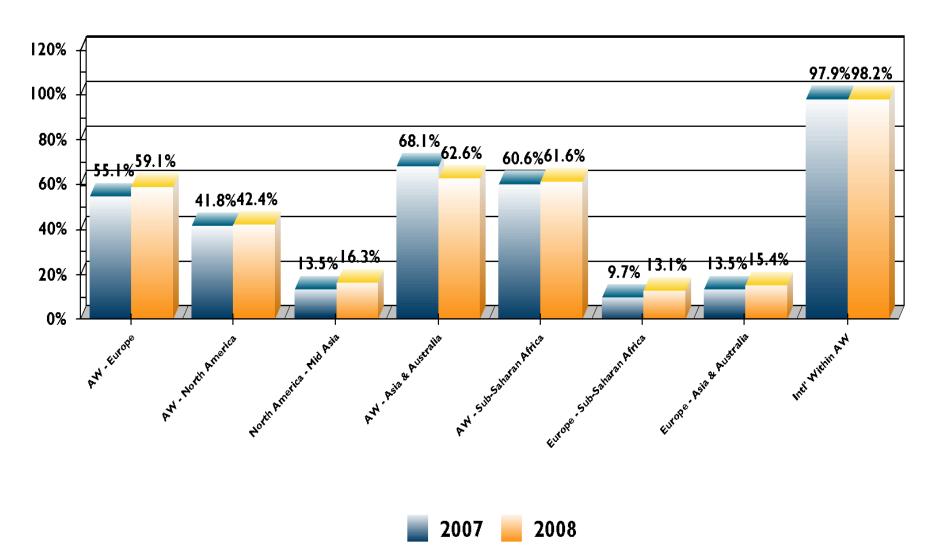
Arab World and Industry GDP and RPKs Growth

An Aero-political gridlock .. almost!

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- ☐ Two Arab liberalization agreements ..not really implemented: the main driving force for liberalization is national agendas
- National economic agendas vary depending on economic attributes .. Hence there is no predominant model that applies regionally
- Privatization & Liberalization of ownership also depend on national economic attributes

Regional approach can only be achieved through creating a critical mass of like minded countries or .. By external affiliation
