Are you on a Co-Op Work Permit?


IRCC has informed us that there was an error on some students' co-op work permits for their mandatory work components. On some work permits, there is a condition stating that the candidate is "not authorized to work for any employer other than stated" OR cannot work for an employer other than the educational institution. This condition is INCORRECT.

For those of you who have this incorrect condition on your co-op work permit, IRCC has informed us that they have prepared a letter that confirms that despite this error you are authorised to work for any employer and are not restricted to work only for the educational institution.

If you are affected by this situation and would like to receive the letter from IRCC, please scan a copy of your work permit to events.iss@mcgill.ca by Friday, February 8th. We will send you a copy of the letter that you may then provide to your employer.

Therefore, you are able to begin your internship or coop with your employer without penalty even if you have this incorrect condition on your co-op work permit.


