Senate Meeting Report, 2024-05-08

The following is a summary of the Senate meeting which took place on May 8, 2024.

The meeting began with memorial tributes being presented by Dean Chan for Professor Wallace Crowston and by Dean Beaudry for Elizabeth Lewis (Libraries). Senate adopted the report of the Steering Committee

The President also noted, in relation to matters recently approved by the Board of Governors, the appointment of Professor Fabrice Labeau to the role of Vice-President (Administration and Finance), the appointment of Professor Angela Campbell as Interim Deputy Provost (Student Life and Learning), and the appointment of Professor Vivek Venkatesh to the role of Dean of the Faculty of Education.

Provost Manfredi presented the third and final budget planning report of the year to Senate https://www.mcgill.ca/senate/files/senate/d23-71 university budget 2024-2025.pdf. In light of the very high level of uncertainty and risk arising from the major changes announced in March 2024 by the Quebec government regarding its funding policies, the Board of Governors has approved a provisional budget plan with a \$12M deficit, including a \$10M contingency. A final FY2025 budget and recovery plan will be presented in fall 2024.
