Things to Consider

Language Requirements

Classes are taught primarily in English at all of our partner institutions located in Oceania and Singapore (except in courses where knowledge of a language is one of the objectives of the course).

Proof of English Proficiency

Because the language of instruction at McGill is English, all outgoing students are exempt from having to prove English proficiency when applying to the host institution.

The Host Application: Oceania + Singapore

I've accepted my nomination to a partner school located in Oceania + Singapore; what documents will I need to apply to the host institution? Are there any supporting documents that I should prepare well in advance?

Documents to Prepare in Advance: Oceania + Singapore

- A Valid Passport
 - Most exchange partners in this region will request a scanned copy of your passport before reviewing your application. Your passport must be valid for at least six months after your scheduled return. If your passport is expiring soon, think about renewing it.
- Course Selections
 - A majority of our partners in this region will ask that you submit a study plan (aka module list, course selections form, etc.) as part of your application. You might not have a lot of time in between your nomination and host application, so begin researching the course offerings at your host school early!

I've been accepted, what must I do before departure?

- Apply for any relevant immigration documents. For more information, consult:

 - Singapore Immigration & Checkpoint Authority http://www.ica.gov.sg/
- Make sure that you have appropriate health and travel insurance
 - Australia + New Zealand: You must purchase acceptable health and travel insurance that covers your entire stay. The host school will advise you on the details of this requirement after you have been accepted.
 - **Singapore:** Health and accident insurance is mandatory and arranged by the host on your behalf.

Note: Please do not apply for any applicable immigration document until your exchange application has been accepted by the host.

On-Campus Housing

Many of our partners cannot guarantee incoming exchange students a space in on-campus housing. Please take this into consideration when researching/choosing your preferred exchange destination. For more information on campus housing, consult individual partner websites.
