COLLABORATOR
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Ability to effectively work with colleagues/healthcare workers ➤ Applicant's response to feedback
PROFESSIONAL
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Demonstration of honesty, integrity and respect ➤ Demonstration of strong sense of responsibility and adherence to professional obligations ➤ Demonstration of commitment to the quality of work
LEADER
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Demonstration of leadership in professional practice and as related to research projects
HEALTH ADVOCATE
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Demonstration of advocacy of patient and/or communities/populations
PERSONAL STATEMENT
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Applicant's commitment to research in general ➤ Justification of training environment ➤ Commitment to the program and to the research project ➤ Future career plans
QUALITY OF RESEARCH PROJECT
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Clarity and conciseness of research topic ➤ Clarity and consistency between the hypotheses and objectives ➤ Relevance of the methods and analyses ➤ Feasibility of the project ➤ Originality of project and contribution to the advancement of knowledge
SUPERVISOR AND RESEARCH TRAINING ENVIRONMENT
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Quality of supervisor(s)'s publication record as it pertains to student research ➤ Quality of the research training program developed by the supervisor and program director
