B.4 Fee Payment Deadlines – 1999-2000

New students are required to make a deposit on tuition shortly after receiving notice of their acceptance to the University. A fee statement indicating the required deposit amount will be mailed to all accepted students and payment will be due at the end of the month in which the statement is mailed.

All students will receive a fee statement once their registration has been confirmed, due at the end of the month in which the statement is mailed. For most returning students this will take place in the month of August (December for the Winter semester). For most new students this will take place in the month of September (January for the Winter semester). Students whose accounts remain unpaid at the end of October (end of February for the Winter semester) will be charged a late payment fee of \$25 over and above interest.
