MOVING IN

CHECK-IN

You will be asked to identify yourself using a government issued ID

There will be two distanced check-in tables at the property entrance under the tunnel. Once completed, you will be issued a key packet which includes:

- 1 key fob
- 1 laundry card
- 1 bedroom key
- 1 mailbox key (1 key per room for a 2 bedroom)

GUESTS DURING MOVE

All resident students are permitted to have guests to assist them during their move. However, guests are not permitted to stay once the move-in is complete.

PARKING

Paid parking is available during the move-in period on the G-1 level of Campus 1 MTL.

UNIT CONDITION FORM

Once you have completed your move-in, you will be required to complete your Unit Condition Form, using this link.

MOVING BINS AND CARTS

Moving bins and carts will be available to any student moving into Campus 1 MTL. They can be signed out from any of the check-in locations located:

- Rez-de-chaussée Passenger Drop Off Move-Ins
- Parking Tunnel Parking Vehicle Move-Ins

You will be asked to exchange ID in order to get the use of a bin.

ROOM INFORMATION

WHAT TO BRING

It might be tempting to bring as much as you can from home but keep in mind that you have limited space in your new residence room. Appliances such as microwaves, toasters, electric oven, rice cooker, coffee maker are not permitted in residence rooms. Here is a list of must-haves to pack or purchase upon arrival.

- Toilet paper & toiletries

- Common area: standing lamps and bulbs
- Broom, dustpan and mop
- Garbage bin and bags
- Cleaning supplies
- Decorative items

When packages arrive at Campus 1 MTL, you will receive an e-mail notification advising you that your package is ready to be picked up.

Packages received prior to move-in day will be stored in your room until your arrival.

FOOD SERVICES

MANDATORY MEAL PLAN - ALL YOU CARE TO EAT

- The All you Care to Eat Campus1 Mandatory Meal Plan is linked directly to your access fob key, giving you unlimited access to the Campus1 MTL dining hall, with no restrictions on how often you enter, or what you eat. Simply tap your fob key upon entering the dining hall and enjoy as much as you care to eat.
- The Mandatory Meal Plan applies to all residents living in residence at Campus1 MTL and will be administered and managed by Campus1, and not McGill dining services

FEES AND PAYMENT

The plan is due in two installments and is payable by the student directly to Campus1 (ECV Montreal LP):

- \$2,900 due on August 31, 2024 for the fall semester (August to December)
- \$2,900 due on December 31, 2024 for the winter semester (January to April)

External guests are welcome to eat in the dining hall but are required to pay for their meals.

Brunch/ Lunch - \$20.89 plus tax

Dinner - \$25.29 plus tax

Special McGill Student Rate:

(If the Guest is a student of McGill and has a current and active student card with face and expiry active, then they are able to receive the following rates)

Breakfast - \$12.95 plus tax Brunch/ Lunch - \$14.95 plus tax

Dinner - \$16.95 plus tax

ONECARD

In addition, you are assigned a <u>oneCard</u> account that can be used at the 15 on-campus dining locations, the McGill Bookstore, and several other services.

- It is directly linked to your McGill ID card.
- There is nothing for you to do, it is automatically activated on August 17, 2024.
