Our EARTH Day sustainability series brought together students and community members across Québec to discuss sustainability education and awareness, the intersection between sustainability and healthcare, and new sustainable initiative in research and technology. The virtual event spanned over 2 evenings and comprised presentations by and discussion between a total of 11 speakers. Our speakers came from a mix of disciplines, and included representation from student groups, university programs, and non-profit organizations each working in their own way to improve our commitment to environmental and sustainable practices. The event promoted discussion regarding the different approaches to sustainability and helped build community around this common issue.

Attendance was lower than anticipated, likely due to Zoom burnout and the first summer weather of the year. In retrospect, it may have been better to start with 1 evening rather than 3 in a row; we had to cancel the sustainability trivia night we had planned for the last evening due to low attendance (we will plan it for September, instead). It would also have been helpful to have a team dedicated to event promotion, as the organizing team was already very busy. Nevertheless, our event page reached 1300 views, more than 500 people saw our event through social media or email, and we had around 40 attendees across the two evenings.

Although our event didn't quite go as intended (e.g. having to cancel the last evening), we really appreciated the level of engagement from the speakers and attendees. We are confident that we could host a larger, well-attended event next year.
