To highlight Earth day, the Green Labs Initiative at the Lady Davis Institute (LDI) wanted to demonstrate our will to make a change towards more sustainable practices in research. For the event, we grew two types of plants to be given away to the LDI community. We managed to prepare 16 individual plants in clay pots. We set up a table in a commun area during lunch time. It gave us the possibility to expose some sustainable lab practice tips on a plastic display. We also had the poster of the event with the GLI at LDI information.

We gave 16 plants across 10 different labs in the institute. These will contribute to a better air quality in the work place. This event also gave our group some visibility across the LDI community and we shared insteresting conversation with our peers about sustainability and the nature of our group.
