Including compost bins at our "park party" helped us significantly reduce the amount of waste we produced. We served pizza and snacks. The pizza boxes themselves were compostable as well as the napkins we provided, so most of the products at our event could be composted. Given that we used this initiative at our first event also gave us the opportunity to advertise sustainability at frosh and McGill to incoming students.

The biggest setback was ensuring we always had someone stationed at each bin to ensure that students were using the compost bins appropriately and not dropping trash into the bins. Although this was not ideal, it ensured everyone at the event understood the importance of the initiative, and provided them with an opportunity to ask questions if they were curious.
