## **Elective Description**

These electives are structured so that the student obtains a broad general knowledge of radiology. This will include the principles of image interpretation, understanding the role of imaging in diagnosis and patient management, and observation of the multiple procedures performed in the radiology department. The students will be exposed as much as possible to the many disciplines whose boundaries are crossed by diagnostic radiology. Attendance at departmental and selected extradepartmental conferences is expected.

## Note to McGill students:

The procedure for scheduling the elective is as follows:

- Complete and submit the online elective placement form.
- Requests are accepted on a first come, first served basis.

Please note that we cannot guarantee your date or hospital preference for the elective.

## **Sub-specialty Electives**

The practice of Diagnostic Radiology at McGill University hospitals is divided into sub-disciplines on the basis of body systems. The student is given the opportunity to select in which of these sub-disciplines the student wishes to spend time: Neuroradiology, Chest Imaging, Abdominal Imaging and Musculoskeletal Imaging.

The student must spend a maximum of 1 week in each specialty, for example for a 2 week elective, the student would spend time in 2 of the 4 specialties.
