Elective Description

Available to one Clerkship student at any one time. The Division of Gastroenterology will accept medical students for a four or six week elective program. Students are urged to see patients in consultation, have their consultations reviewed by an attending member of the Division of Gastroenterology, and follow the patient through the GI lab for any investigations. He/she should be exposed to several different endoscopic procedures and pathology to be aware of indications, complications, and limitations of these procedures. Students taking an elective in Gastroenterology fall under the direct supervision of the trainee in Gastroenterology and the attending physician on consultations.

Scope of Work

Formal teaching includes the bi-weekly Conferences, the Grand Medical Rounds, the Gastrointestinal-Radiology bi-weekly Conference, and attending rounds in Gastroenterology. Students on electives will be urged to attend the seminars for ICM students. Outpatient experience is available as well in GI clinics, adjacent to the GI Endoscopy laboratory.
