Passport Information

Canadians and Americans again require a visa to enter Brazil. Many EU countries do not require a visa. Passport requires a minimum of 6 months remaining after date of entry

Students should check with the Brazilian consulate/embassy [website](#) to see if they need a visa to enter Brazil.
